

To Students Applying for the Teaching Fellow Positions

Teaching Fellow Training (Autumn time)

Osaka University has established "Teaching Assistant (TA)" and "Teaching Fellow (TF)" to provide detailed guidance in common education and undergraduate education.

Of these, TF is in charge of works that require more advanced and comprehensive, perspective, design ability, and action ability such as participating in the planning and development of lessons under the guidance of teachers with the aim of improving skills as an instructor and developing educational development ability.

Students applying for TF positions must meet certain requirements, including attending preliminary online training which will be held as shown in the attachment. Without attending the training, no one is permitted to work as a TF.

Note that attending the training does not guarantee acceptance as a TF: whether you are hired as a TF or not depends on the policies and tasks of the graduate schools/centers that seek TFs. For more information, inquire at the relevant section of the graduate school/center seeking TAs and TFs.

● How to apply for the training

Fill in the form “**Application for TF Training (Autumn time)**” available on KOAN as a general survey. We will inform students who applied for TF training how to attend CLE course. If you apply for TF seminar, be sure to take CLE course by the day when TF online training will be held. (TF online seminar consists of CLE course and TF online training, and if you would like to be a TF, you have to take both.)

Application deadline: Sunday, August 29, 2021 [The deadline must be met.]

Reference information

○ TF is stipulated to be “mainly responsible for supporting educational activities deemed necessary by the relevant graduate school/center under educational guidance of academic staff for undergraduate and master’s students, and also for planning for such educational support tasks on his or her own and implementing the tasks while controlling the progress of lectures.” Accordingly, a TF takes on higher-level educational support tasks than a TA.

○ Only students who meet all the following requirements are qualified as TFs.

(1) Graduate students in doctoral degree programs* with outstanding academic performance

(2) Students who have experience of working as a TA for more than 18 hours (including those who are deemed to have equivalent teaching experience at universities or other educational and research institutions)

(3) Students who have completed TF training conducted within the past four years from the date of acceptance as a TF.

* For students of the Graduate School of Frontier Biosciences, eligibility is limited to those in the third and subsequent years of the five-year doctoral degree program.

For students of Osaka University Law School, eligibility is limited to students in the third year and beyond.

For students of the Graduate School of Frontier Biosciences, eligibility is limited to those in the third and subsequent years of the five-year doctoral degree program.

※Students who completed “Course Design and Teaching I” don’t have to take TF training (However, everyone must take CLE work). In that case, please send an e-mail to “Contact for Inquiries”. Its subject line as is to be “Apply to Exemption from TF training” and let us know your Student Number, affiliation graduate school, your name and its credit acquisition on your message.

- Note that this training only gives a qualification to work as a TF. Whether you are hired as a TF or not depends on the policies and tasks of the graduate schools/centers that seek TFs.
- Please note that there is no reward (including transportation expenses) for the TF training (CLE work and online training on 9/21).
